### Announcement to Young Internists/Researchers from EFIM Member Countries

I am pleased to announce that the 11th EFIM-FDIME Seminar on Clinical Research will be held in Paris from 6th to 8th July (Residents arrive Sunday 5th July and depart 8th July after lunch).

Sponsorship for this Seminar is provided by Amgen through the Foundation for the Development of Internal Medicine in Europe (FDIME). This enables us to offer up to 17 bursaries to young internists from EFIM member countries who are interested to develop their career in Clinical Research. The bursaries will fund hotel accommodation for 3 nights, and economy-rate travel from your country of residence to Paris and the return journey.

Eligibility: Applicants must come from a country affiliated to EFIM; be under the age of 35 years; have a good knowledge of English. All lectures and interaction will be in English. Applicants must have basic knowledge of biostatistics and methodology, and have some personal experience in clinical research.

Note: The candidates who will be selected to attend the Seminar are respectfully requested not to bring partners, friends or other family members as we cannot accommodate them or include them in any aspect of the educational or social program.

The Clinical Research Organizing & Selection Committee members are: Prof Daniel Sereni (Chair), Prof Loic Guillevin, Dr Chris Davidson, and Dr Lenka Bosanska. We will consider all applicants who meet the Eligibility Criteria. The successful applicants will receive a Letter of Acceptance within four weeks of the closing date, and they will be responsible for making their own travel bookings. Note that Travel expenses will be refunded to the Residents after they have attended the Seminar.
