Aim of the symposium

To bring internists from Türkiye and Portugal together around the problems that define contemporary internal medicine, multimorbidity, polypharmacy, cardiometabolic and immune-mediated disease, and to move beyond lectures towards shared clinical reasoning and joint multicenter research.

The program has two parts. Mornings are joint scientific sessions of the two societies, with a chair and speakers from each. Afternoons are DAHUDER working sessions, clinical case discussions, and workshops of DAHUDER's multicenter research network, open to any SPMI colleague who wishes to attend.
